#### **DAILY STORE RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Review installation manuals
- Print new pick-ticket and check product while loading to verify all correct components
- Load and unload install truck

- Re-stock unused parts (pipe, etc.)
- Break down garbage into dumpster
- Assist in documentation of jobs; download pictures into customers' files

## **DAILY FIELD RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Help unload fireplace/stove/insert/grill, etc.
- Help install product including running gas line, electric, vent, chimney liner, finished facing
- All tasks are under the guidance of the lead installer
- Keep list of materials needed to re-stock the truck
- Keep list of tools needed to be replaced, serviced, purchased as directed by lead installer
- Document parts used/parts needed for paperwork
- Take pictures throughout the installation of important aspects that need to be documented

- Walk customer through operation / use of appliance
- Upload pictures into SharePoint and fill out paperwork before leaving the job
